As mandated by the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), this bound training manual is organized in an easy to read format and outlines the nine required learning components:

- background, rationale and coverage of the DOT's drug and alcohol testing program;
- 49 C.F.R. § 40 and DOT agency drug and alcohol testing rules;
- key DOT drug testing requirements, including collections, laboratory testing, MRO review and problems in drug testing;
- key DOT alcohol testing requirements, including the testing process, the roles of BATs and STTs and problems in alcohol testing;
- SAP qualifications and prohibitions;
- the role of the SAP in the return-to-duty process, including the initial employee evaluation, referrals for education and/or treatment, the follow-up evaluation, continuing treatment recommendations and the follow-up testing plan;
- SAP consultation and communication with employers, MROs and treatment providers;
- reporting and record keeping requirements; and
- issues that SAPs confront in carrying out their duties under the program.

The Independent Study Course also includes an examination (validated 50-item written examination for initial qualification; 25-item online examination for re-qualification). Participants who achieve a passing score of 75% or higher will be issued a Substance Abuse Professional (SAP) Qualification Certificate to frame and display in your office and a Certificate of Completion for 12 CEs. SAPs qualified through NAADAC are afforded three years of maintenance-free eligibility to practice as an SAP, as well as a free listing of your contact information on our website to help advertise your services.
