Description: In the early 1970s, it was determined that the profession of addiction counseling needed guidelines to govern itself. At this time, the profession was not viewed favorably nor taken seriously. NAADAC, the Association of Addiction Professionals, determined that in order to assist the profession to better its identity, standards of ethics should be developed. Those standards still govern our profession and our practice today.

NAADAC has recently updated its Code of Ethics to reflect the current ethical climate. This presentation will address the new national ethics standards for addiction professionals. Topics of discussion will include: self-disclosure, scopes of practice, confidentiality regulations, mandatory reporting and many other adjunct issues will be addressed.
