

Change is Coming: New Regulations in 2012 for Diagnosis Codes and Claims Submission

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Description: On January 1, 2012, electronic transaction standards for insurance claims will change from Version 4010/4010A to Version 5010, paving the way for the release of ICD-10 in October 2013. All healthcare providers that are covered under the Health Insurance Portability

and Accountability Act (HIPAA) will be required to comply with these new standards—beginning in less than four short months. Is your organization ready for this change?

During this webinar, we will cover the upcoming changes in both ANSI Version 5010 and in the ICD-10 diagnosis code sets. Both of these transitions will greatly affect how providers submit claims electronically and how reimbursement from payers will be impacted if the new standards are not understood or met.
