



RULES GOVERNING EXHIBITION

1. Eligible Exhibits -- NAADAC has the sole right to determine the eligibility of any company or product for inclusion in the Exhibition.
2. Limitation of Liability -- Neither NAADAC nor Holiday Inn SunSpree Resort nor any of their officers, agents, employees or other representatives, shall be held liable for, and are hereby released from liability for any damage, loss, harm or injury to the person or property of the Exhibitor or any of its offers, agents, employees or other representatives, resulting from theft, fire, water, accident or any other cause. The Exhibitor shall indemnify, defend and protect NAADAC, and hold and save NAADAC harmless from any and all claims, demands, suits, liability, damages, loss, attorney's fees and expenses of whatever kind or nature, which might result from or arise out of any action or failure to act on the part of the Exhibitor or any of its officers, agents, employees or other representatives.
3. Damage to Property -- Exhibitor is liable for any damage caused to building floors, walls, furniture, or to other Exhibitor's property.
4. Obstruction of Aisles or Booths -- All demonstrations or activities shall be located within the designated booth area of the Exhibitor. Excessive obstruction of aisles or prevention of ready access to nearby Exhibitors' booths is strictly prohibited and all activities will be suspended by Management until obstruction is removed.
5. Sound levels -- No noisy or obstructive work is permitted during open hours of the Exhibition, nor will noisy operating displays be allowed.
6. Age Limitation -- You must be 16 years of age or older to be admitted to the exhibition or conference.
7. Exhibit Property Removal -- Exhibitors may not remove material without proper identification and authorization from the exhibit area. Exhibitors may authorize removal of their own property.
8. Exhibitor Withdrawal --
All cancellations must be forwarded in writing to NAADAC Exhibits. A fee equal to 50% of the full booth price will be assessed if cancellation is postmarked sixty (60) days prior to the opening of the annual meeting; no refunds after this date.
9. Failure to Hold Exhibition -- Should NAADAC cancel Exhibitions, in whole or in part, as the result of riot, strike, civil disorder, act of war, act of God, or any other reason of any kind whatsoever not within NAADAC' control, the Exhibitor shall receive a refund less 25% of the exhibition fee.
