## CONFERENCE SPEAKERS

**LARRY ASHLEY, EdS, LADC, CPGC**, is a college professor, researcher and therapist with 30 years of experience in substance abuse and trauma. Due to his extensive clinical experience coupled with opportunities for local, national and international speaking engagements, Professor Ashley is considered to be a leading expert on post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and issues related to addictions. He has a special interest on the impact of war on soldiers world-wide. He is currently the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV), Addiction Specialist and Undergraduate Coordinator.

**PATRICIA GREER, BA, LCDC, AAC**, serves as President of NAADAC, the Association for Addiction Professionals, and is a member of the Dallas Chapter of the Texas Association of Addiction Professionals (TAAP). She is the recipient of the TAAP Elvies Smith Counselor of the Year Award, 2005. She has chosen to work in just about every alcohol and drug related service environment. Administration, counseling, prevention, education, family therapy, and clinical supervision have all been part of her training and work. When she moved to Texas with her family in 1982, she brought her interests in non-profit service delivery with her.

**MARY HARSH, PhD**, has a doctorate in clinical psychology from Pacific Graduate School of Psychology in Palo Alto, Calif. Dr. Harsh has worked with veterans for approximately 23 years. She has worked at three Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Medical Centers, and completed advanced training at the National Center for Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder at the VA in Menlo Park, Calif. Currently, she is in private practice in Helena, Mont.

**RONALD K. HULL, MD**, has worked in private practice in Helena and Bozeman, Mont., since 1976. He earned his undergraduate degree at Kansas State University and his medical degree at the University of Kansas Medical Center. His professional memberships and certifications include certification by the American Society of Addiction Medicine and memberships in the American Academy of Pain medicine and the International Society of Interventional Specialists.

**COLONEL JEFFREY E. IRELAND** is the Director of Manpower and Personnel for the Montana Joint Forces Headquarters. He is responsible to provide manpower and personnel policy and oversight for the Montana National Guard, to provide consistent human resources management systems that shape and enhance strategic initiatives, personnel readiness, operational capabilities, and the sustainability of the Montana National Guard community. Prior to his appointment as the Director of

Manpower and Personnel, he served as Commander, 208th Regiment, Montana Regional Training Institute at Fort Harrison, Mont.

**CARROLL JENKINS** is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker and Licensed Addictions Counselor. He has been in private practice for 30 years specializing in anxiety disorders and chemical dependency with an emphasis on post traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). In the past, he operated the Vietnam Veteran Outreach Project, was an adjunct professor at Carroll College and recently provided training for the Montana National Guard. He has served as the President of the Montana Mental Health Association and Director of the National Mental Health Association. He is a combat veteran and currently serves as President of the Montana Veteran's Foundation.

**ROBERT RICHARDS, MA, CADC II, NCAC II**, is the NAADAC Regional Vice President for the Northwest Region. He is also the past president of AADACO, Association of Alcohol & Drug Abuse Counselors of Oregon, NAADAC's Oregon affiliate. He has been a board member of AADACO for the past seven years and has served as a NAADAC Board member for the past four years. He currently serves as the Director of the Buckley Center in Eugene, Ore. and is past president of Oregon Detox Providers Association. He has been a proud member of NAADAC for over 15 years.
