NAADAC / TAAP 2005 Annual Conference Wrap Up

NAADAC, the Association for Addiction Professionals joined together with its Texas affiliate, the Texas Association of Addiction Professionals (TAAP) this July to present NAADAC's first combined national and state conference from July 7-9, 2005. The conference titled, *Catch the Wave to Corpus: II*, was an overwhelming success and attracted 400 addiction professionals from throughout the nation. NAADAC President Mary Woods, RNC, LADC, MSHS was pleased with the result. "We are very proud of our partnership with TAAP and will use this as a model for NAADAC's future conferences. Instead of competing with our affiliates we look forward to working with them and strengthening our association," she stated at the conference.

Included in the proceedings were over 45 workshops, seminars and plenary sessions, NAADAC and TAAP Board of Directors meetings, NAADAC and TAAP Certification Commission Meetings, a Political Action Committee (PAC) luncheon and a Presidents' Dinner co-hosted by TAAP President Jennifer Carr, LCDC, CPS and Mary Woods.

NAADAC Finances Improve

One of the key presentations from the conference was the Treasurer's Report submitted by Paul Potter. Potter reported that there had been a dramatic turnaround in the finances from the previous year. 2004 was a difficult year for NAADAC as it faced a financial downturn. The Board of Directors recognized the need to change direction and made plans to reduce expenses and raise revenue. Potter announced that those plans were successful and NAADAC is making excellent progress towards financial health. In nine months, revenues have increased and expenses been reduced. All major outstanding debts for 2005 have been paid and \$10,000 has been placed in the NAADAC reserve fund. Potter stated, "We are looking forward to moving in

a positive direction in terms of our finances and with our organization in the upcoming year".

Merger Discussions Progress

NAADAC President Mary Woods, Acting Executive Director Cynthia Moreno Tuohy and National Certification Chair William Cote were available to address the ongoing discussions on the NAADAC/IC&RC merger discussions. The discussions have two aspects: the first involving the amalgamation of NAADAC and IC&RC credentials and the second regarding the "unification through merger" of the NAADAC and IC&RC organizations. The NAADAC Board of Directors were supportive of the discussions, but stressed the importance of states being consulted as these discussions progress. The NAADAC Executive Committee was optimistic that these discussions would be finalized by the end of 2005.

Presidents' Dinner

The highlight of the TAAP and NAADAC conference was the Presidents' Dinner. Those at the dinner were fortunate to hear from Aaron Peña, a representative in the Texas state legislature. Peña's family has personally been touched by addiction, as his son John died from a drug overdose. The dinner concluded with a presentation by Christopher Lawford Kennedy, the first child of Peter Lawford and Pat Kennedy. Lawford Kennedy shared his personal tale of his battle with addiction and the pressures he faces on a daily basis. Lawford Kennedy urged the audience to remember "it's not just who you are, but who you help." Lawford Kennedy also offered praise for addiction professionals, saying "This is the only job where you treat one person and a whole family gets well."
