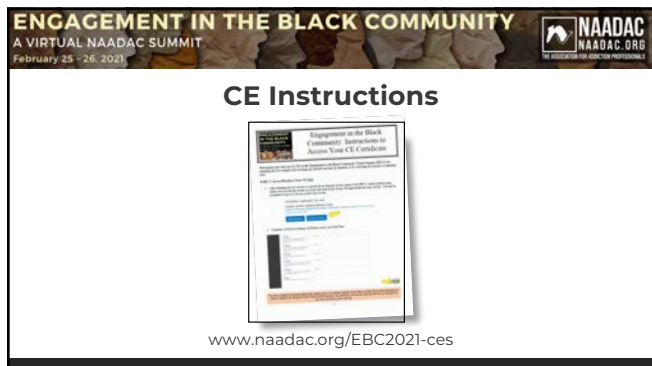



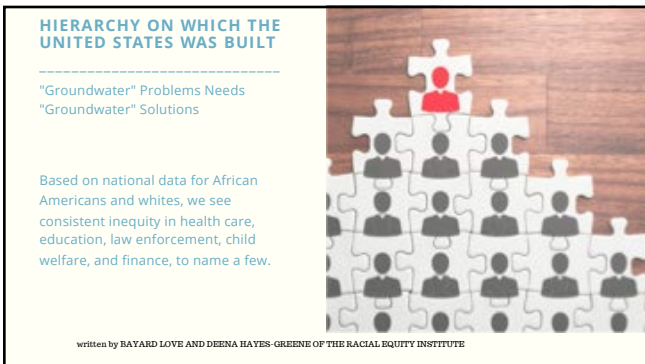

HISTORICAL FACTORS IN THE BLACK COMMUNITY:

- Historical Trauma/Intergenerational Trauma
- Unresolved Grief
- Loss of culture
- Community Trauma
- Discrimination
- High arrest and imprisonment rates
- Addiction is compounded by historical and institutional factors

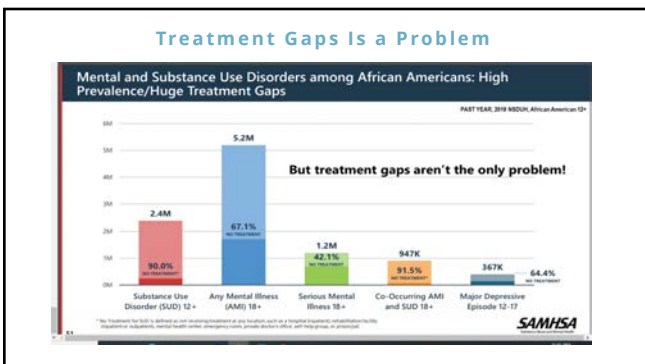
- The War on Drugs: Drug Law Policies in the 1970s and 1980s criminalized addiction

Statistical Perspective

- African Americans are 7.0 times more likely to be incarcerated as adults (Bureau of Justice).
- African Americans are 1.8 times more likely to be identified as victims by the child welfare system (DHHS).
- In 2019, 6.5m African American had a MI and/or SUD this increase by 10% since 2018 in both SUD and MI (National Survey on Drug Use & Health).
